A waterless hand sanitizing gel which sanitises the skin without the need for water. Ideal for use on entering food production areas, or before handling food.

An alcohol based product for use in any situation where bactericidal control is important.

Important - the use of towels or tissue may lead to re-contamination with bacteria. Application to dry cracked or cut skin should be avoided.

Senses Hand Sanitizing Gel complies with the challenge test against the following organisms using an adaptation of the European Suspension Test (BSEN 1276): E Coli, Salmonella Typhimurium, Listeria Monocytogenes, Methicillin resistant Staphylococcus Aureus (MRSA).

Directions for Use

Apply a small amount to the hands and rub in well, paying particular attention to finger nails and the area between the fingers. Allow hands to air dry.
